Salvador Dalí: A Portrait of the Artist as a Young Man in a Modernista Landscape

Salvador Dalí was born in Figueres (Catalonia, Spain) in 1904, at the height of the modernist movement. His childhood and adolescence were spent in an architectural landscape and cultural atmospheres dominated by Art Nouveau and Catalanism. This paper aims to analyze how this landscape and these cultural environments have helped to set the artistic personality of Dalí through the analysis of his literary, from the autobiographical works such as *Diary*, *1919-1920* to his most well known *The Secret Life of Salvador Dalí* (1941). From Figueres to New York, from the Modernism to the anti-Modernism, the latter, "the novel of the artist" Salvador Dalí written by himself on his own life shows the evolution of the modern artist in the 20th century.
